



CIRRUS TRANSITION TRAINING Pre-Training Checklist

Prior to conducting flight training on your new Cirrus aircraft please ensure that training has been arranged with us 14 days prior to arrival and the pilot profile and certificate of insurance is sent or faxed at least 5 days prior training:

- Training Schedule / Personal Schedule**
Additional training days may be required. We strongly urge you to schedule in advance the required number of training days as it relates to your experience level (a minimum of 2-3 days per person must be scheduled). Please view the website or call to discuss your training options and plans. We are often unable to accommodate last-minute requests for extra training days or services.

- Pilot Profile**
Please complete and fax the pilot profile form to us so we have the appropriate information on file. Be sure to include a copy of your pilot licenses, driver license, pilot medical and a completed application.

- Certificate of Insurance**
Please provide us with your broker contact information. We will need to be named as additionally insured with a waiver of subrogation on your policy prior to training in your aircraft. This is a very simple process and rarely do we encounter any problems. Flight training cannot be provided without this certificate.

- Training Material**
Training Guide worksheets (first half of training guide) are required to be completed to begin the first lesson of the transition training course. Incomplete worksheets will equate to additional training time. Having the worksheets completed will allow more flight time and less time on the ground.

☐ **Charts**

Remember that your MFD does not replace the need to have charts with you on board the aircraft. It is advised, to purchase your charts and have them with you when you begin your training in Morristown, NJ. (IFR/VFR)

☐ **Credit Card**

To secure your training dates we will need a valid credit card number on file. Your card will not be billed until completion of your training.
